Hanji Edition 2021

Hanji Edition is a collection of fine art works on hanji, or Korean handmade paper. This second volume in a series was published in 2021 and features experimental works by five artists from around the world. All hanji used in the portfolio was produced at Jangjibang, a hanji mill in South Korea. Included is a handbound booklet with letterpress printed hanji covers, an introductory essay by publishers Steph Rue and Lars Kim, and biographies and short essays by each artist. The custom enclosure measures 10 $\frac{1}{12}$ x 11 $\frac{1}{12}$ x 3 $\frac{3}{16}$ inches. Hanji Edition is available for \$1750 and comes in an edition of 20.
